In Association with J&J Snack Foods Handheld Corp., ALDI Voluntarily Recalls Fit & Active Southwest Veggie Stuffed Sandwich Due to Possible Health Risk

Batavia, Ill. (Oct. 29, 2018) – In cooperation with J&J Snack Foods Handheld Corp., ALDI has voluntarily recalled its Fit & Active Southwest Veggie Stuffed Sandwich as a precautionary measure due to possible *Listeria monocytogenes* and Salmonella contamination.

The potentially affected products have a UPC Code of 4149815117, and a best-by date of Feb. 9, 2019 and Feb. 14, 2019. The impacted product was sold in ALDI stores in Alabama, Connecticut, Delaware, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, Massachusetts, Maryland, Mississippi, North Carolina, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New York, Ohio, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, South Carolina, Tennessee, Virginia, Vermont and West Virginia. The product was also available for purchase to ALDI customers in the Atlanta area through the company's partnership with Instacart, a grocery delivery service.

ALDI discontinued the affected products in 2017. However, J&J Snack Foods Handheld Corp. and ALDI are concerned that some product may be frozen and stored in freezers. People who have purchased these products are urged not to consume them. These products should be thrown away or returned to the place of purchase.

To date, no illnesses related to this product have been reported. No other ALDI products are affected by this recall.

ALDI takes the safety and integrity of the products it sells seriously. If customers have product affected by this voluntary recall, they should discard it immediately or return it to their local store for a full refund.
